PUBLIC CAN CHOOSE FORMAT FOR PLANNING DOCUMENTS

To save money on printing costs, the Dillon Field Office of the Bureau of Land Management is offering the public an opportunity to choose the format in which they would like to receive the Draft Resource Management Plan (RMP) and Environmental Impact Statement. Individuals and groups can receive a traditional volume of printed material or opt for a compact disk (CD) when it is released to the public in March, 2004.

In preparation for printing, the Dillon Field Office needs an estimate of how many copies to print and how many CDs to have made. The multi-volume document will also be available at BLM offices throughout Montana, public libraries, and at other locations throughout the planning area. The document will also be available through the Dillon RMP website after it is released to the public.

If you work or play on BLM administered lands in Madison and Beaverhead Counties, Montana, you will have an interest in the proposed management of those lands for the next 10 years.
